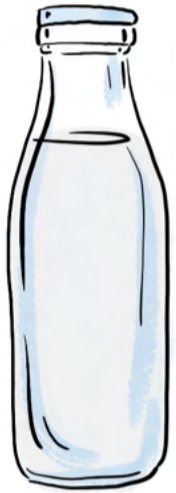

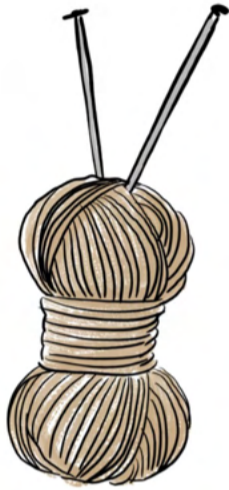
HUMANS HAVE BEEN FARMING SHEEP FOR OVER 10,000 YEARS.

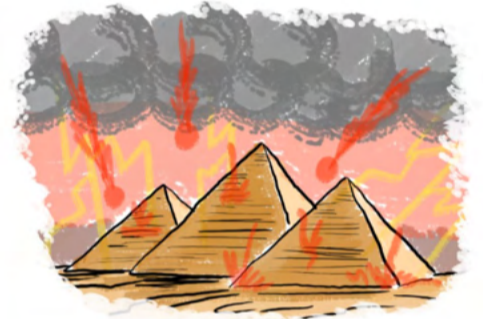


WOOL

LAMBS ALSO PLAY AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN RELIGIOUS SCRIPTURE.



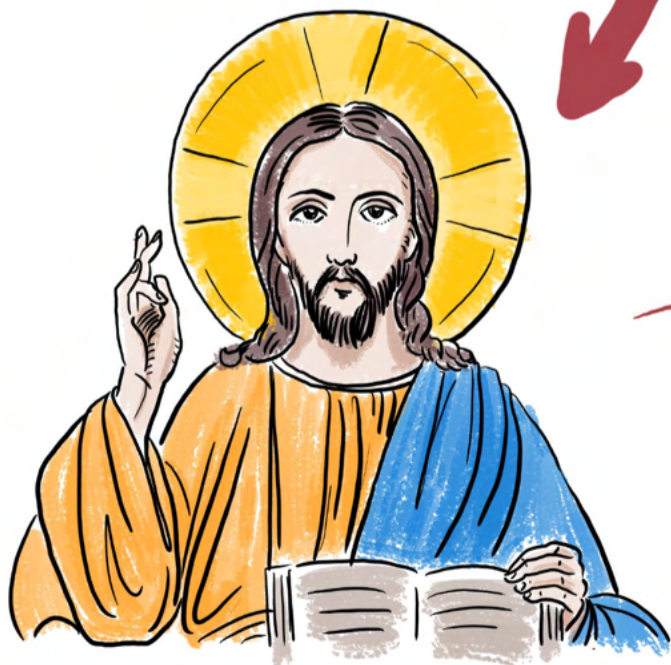

A LAMB ALSO PLAYS THE ROLE OF SAVIOUR IN THE CHRISTIAN CELEBRATION OF EASTER AND OF THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST.

THE BIBLE COMPARES JESUS WITH A LAMB, AS HE DIED TO SAVE THE WORLD FROM SIN.

PASSOVER COMMEMORATES THE BIBLICAL ACCOUNT OF WHEN THE JEWS FLED EGYPT.



DURING HIS LAST SUPPER, JESUS SHARED BREAD AND WINE WITH HIS DISCIPLES.

WINE IS AN EMBLEM FOR THE BLOOD OF CHRIST AND RECALLS THE LAMB'S BLOOD WHICH SAVED THE JEWS.
