



FAQ – Birthday parties in the JuniorAcademy

When should we arrive?

We recommend you arrive 15 minutes in advance, so that participants have time to get ready and feel comfortable (cloakroom, toilets, washing hands, introductions, etc.).

How many activity leaders will be there?

Two activity leaders will be present throughout the cookery workshop.

Who can join the birthday tea?

Only the birthday boy or birthday girl, his/her parents, and the children invited to the party can share the 'cake and candles' moment.

Can parents take part in the cookery workshop?

Unfortunately not, unless a child has a disability and needs assistance.

Who can be there when the gifts are unwrapped and during the games?

Both parents. One parent *must* be present, especially during the half hour playing games, as the activity leaders will not be on hand at that time.

Should I bring party cups and plates? Do I need to help set things up?

The Alimentarium provides cups and plates and prepares the table for you.

Can I bring some extra snacks (crisps, savoury nibbles, cupcakes...)?

Yes, of course. Please note though that there is only half an hour allotted for the birthday tea and unwrapping gifts.

Will the room be decorated? If not, can I bring decorations?

We do not provide birthday decorations, but parents are welcome to decorate the area themselves at the following times:

First scheduled birthday party: Between 14:00 & 14:15 Second scheduled birthday party: Between 16:15 & 16:30

Can we take pictures in the kitchen?

One of the parents of the birthday boy/birthday girl can access the culinary workshop to take photos at the following times:

First scheduled birthday party: Between 14:45 & 15:00 Second scheduled birthday party: Between 16:15 & 16:3
